Rules for Tuition Scholarship:

HI Plan competition - UH Hilo student tuition scholarship eligibility

The highest scoring student or members of the highest scoring student team will
be awarded a tuition scholarship for the Fall 2020 and Spring 2021 semesters at

UH Hilo. The scholarship is worth the full amount of State of Hawai'i resident
tuition.

A student is defined as an individual who is enrolled in UH Hilo during the competition phase. The student must maintain enrollment at UH Hilo in the following academic year and be registered for classes in order to use the tuition scholarship award. The tuition scholarship cannot be used at any other campus within the University of Hawai'i System.

To qualify as a student team, all members of the team must be enrolled in UH Hilo during the competition phase. Team members must individually maintain enrollment in the following academic year and be registered for classes to use their tuition scholarship award. The tuition scholarship cannot be used at any other campus within the University of Hawai'i System.

The total amount of two-semester tuition scholarships for student teams is capped at a maximum for 4 team members, at the full amount of the State of Hawai'i resident tuition. In the event there are more than 4 team members, all team members will equally share the amount of 4 full State of Hawai'i resident tuition scholarships.
